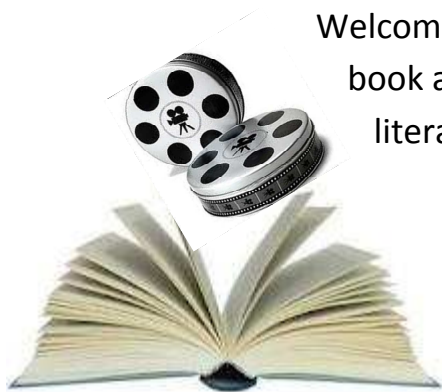


# COURSE DESCRIPTION
